

MARRIAGE & SINGLEHOOD

Matt 19:1-11

(Matt. 19)¹ When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went into the region of Judea to the other side of the Jordan. ² Large crowds followed him, and he healed them there. ³ Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?" ⁴ "Haven't you read," he replied, "*that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,'* ⁵ *and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'?*"

(Matt. 19) 6 So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate.” 7 “Why then,” they asked, “did Moses command that a man give his wife a certificate of divorce and send her away?” 8 Jesus replied, “Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. 9 *I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another woman commits adultery.*”

(Matt. 19) ¹⁰ The disciples said to him, "If this is the situation between a husband and wife, it is better not to marry." ¹¹ *Jesus replied, "Not everyone can accept this word, but only those to whom it has been given. ¹² For some are eunuchs because they were born that way; others have been made eunuchs; and others have renounced marriage because of the kingdom of heaven. The one who can accept this should accept it."*

JESUS' VIEW ON DIVORCE

NOT THE WAY INTENDED

DIVORCE AS "CONCESSION" BUT
CANNOT BE "FOR ANY AND EVERY REASON"

GENDER EQUALITY

He may divorce her even if he found another fairer than she”

SINGLENES AS CALLING

^{12c} and others have renounced marriage because of the kingdom of heaven.

SINGLENES AS CALLING

"RENOUNCED" - A DELIBERATE CHOICE

IN CONTRAST TO NOT HAVING A CHOICE

IN CONTRAST TO A CHOICE MADE OUT
OF COWARDICE AND EVASION OF RESPONSIBILITY

BRIDE OF CHRIST

²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, ²⁶ that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷ so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.

BRIDE OF CHRIST

⁷ Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready.

REV 19

¹⁷ The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.
